

## 2021 Two-Person Championship

Friday & Sat, May 7 - 8	Tee times begin at 8:00am	Report to cart 15 minutes early

- Two-day event, gross and net; sweeps and trophies
- Players may choose to play either day for day-money. Trophies and overall prizes will be awarded to 36-hole players
- Different format for each 9 holes
- 90% of course handicap; maximum of 10 stroke differential between teammates
- Sign up as a two-person team—foursomes paired by Pro Shop
- Both players must play from same tee box; specify tee box at time of registration
- Only first 9 holes are postable
- Awards and Lite Fare following Day 2 of the tournament

Optional purchases: Pay by Venmo @RC WGA by 5/5 or cash at registration on Day 1 only

## **Description of Play:**

Front Nine (Day 1): Best Ball of Twosome (45% of individual handicap) – Each player plays her own ball. The lower score (gross and net) is recorded. The 9-hole Best Ball scores will be posted by the player at the completion of the tournament.

Back Nine (Day 1): Shamble (45% of individual handicap) – Both players tee off on each hole. The best shot is selected, and from this position each player plays her own ball. The best score of the two (gross and net) is then recorded on the hole. Three tee shots must be used from each player. After the tee shot ONLY, players may improve the lie one club length, no closer to the hole. The ball must stay in the same turf condition, i.e. rough, bunker.

Front Nine (Day 2): Chapman (25% of team handicap) – Both players tee off on each hole. After the tee shot, Player A hits Player B's ball, and Player B hits Player A's ball. After this point, the best shot is selected and play alternates, beginning with the player whose shot was not selected. After the tee shot, the ball must be played down. Unless damaged through the normal course of play, the ball may not be substituted during the course of the hole.

Back Nine (Day 2): Odd/Even Alternate Shot (25% of team handicap) – Each team selects one player to tee off on the odd numbered holes, and the other on the even numbered holes. After the tee shot on each hole, play will be a strict alternate shot. Unless damaged through the normal course of play, the ball may not be substituted during the course of the hole.

All putts must be completed.
