

Tournament Details

Eligibility: For all tournaments except the two WGA member + partner tournaments, all players must be WGA members. Any non-WGA member who enters a tournament will automatically become a WGA member and must pay the prevailing WGA dues prior to teeing off.

Handicap: The most current handicap available at the time the lineup is created will be used. 100% of handicap will be used unless noted on tournament sheet. The maximum individual course handicap will be 40 (prior to adjustments), except for 9-hole tournaments. River Creek WGA Handicap Policies and Procedures, which are posted on the WGA website, will be applied to tournaments.

Cost: Any event fees noted are fees due to the WGA. Players may incur additional fees to the Club, depending on your membership.

Optional Purchases: These can be paid with cash or by VENMO at least two days prior to the tournament date and cannot be charged to the Club. Optional purchases must be used by the player/purchaser and are non-transferrable to other players.

Awards: Where noted, there will be an awards ceremony after the event. Sweeps amounts are based on participation. To the extent mathematically possible, we target payout to 30% of the field. Exact places and sweeps amounts will be announced at the time of the event.

Code of Conduct During Tournaments: All play will be governed under the WGA Code of Conduct. These rules apply to the acceptable pace of play and any distractions caused toward fellow players. These rules may be found on the WGA Website at https://www.rivercreekwga.com/code-of-conduct

Foul Weather/Tournament Cancellation Policy: If the tournament is discontinued or delayed due to foul weather (or other unforeseen reasons), the winner will be based on the number of holes that all WGA players have completed. If play is interrupted and then resumed, play will continue until the Pro Shop has declared that it is too dark to continue. Winners will be based on the total number of holes that everybody in the field has completed. Ties will be broken by using hole handicaps (#1 handicap hole, #2 handicap hole, etc.) of the holes that everybody has played. If an event is cancelled, for whatever reason, it may not be able to be rescheduled.

Score Cards: For all 2-player team and individual tournaments, score cards are to be exchanged on the first tee. At the completion of the round, all score cards are to be signed, dated, attested and returned to the Pro Shop.
